

PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Program Admission Requirements

Applicants will be required to meet the following minimum criteria:

Minimum admission requirement for entry to this program is a **Bachelor's Degree** in any field of study.

International Students will need to submit a proof of English Language Competency by any one of the following methods: IELTS Score of 5.5 Bands or More or CLB Score of 6 or more or English Language Test or Interview conducted by the College Authorities.

Domestic Students: Grade 10 English. English Language Proficiency Assessment Test conducted by the College (based on CLB benchmarks), with a grade of 60% or more. Any 3-credit course in English/Communication completed in a Post-Secondary Institution in Canada


